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
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



Note: The mirror must be hung on a wall. It is not designed to rest on the floor or on any type of furniture.

- Identify where the mirror is to be hung on the wall.
- Using a pencil mark the center of the top of the mirror as shown in **Figure 1**.



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• Using a level, draw a 6" horizontal line 3-3/4" down from the point marked in Step 1 as shown in **Figure 2**.




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- Place the wall bracket on the horizontal line with the hole side down and flush with the wall. Be sure that the center hole is aligned with the center of the horizontal line as shown in **Figure 3**.
- Trace the hole locations on the wall as shown.
- Remove the bracket and drill 1/8" holes in the marked locations if going into wood. Drill a 1/4" if attaching to dry wall or plaster.

Note: Wall anchors must be used if hanging the mirror on dry wall, plaster, or tile.

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• Align the bracket on the mirror with the bracket on the wall (as shown in **Figure 4**) and gently slide the mirror until the mirror bracket rests firmly on the wall bracket.

- Install the wall anchors if they are required.
- Attach the bracket to the wall using the screws provided.
- Be sure to confirm that the bracket is level prior to completely tightening the screws. Adjust as necessary.
